We are delighted to announce the exhibition opening of sculpturer Jong Oh - Artist in Residence at KRINZINGER PROJEKTE, Schottenfeldgasse 45, 1070 Vienna on March 3rd, 2015. On invitation by Ursula Krinzinger Jong Oh participated at the outstanding gallery project as Artist in Residence Vienna from November to December 2014. The works shown in the exhibition were all produced during his stay in Vienna.

Through manipulations of simple materials I create artworks that lead to philosophical ponderings of the physical space we occupy. String, weights, dowels, paint, Plexiglas, and graphite lines are arranged in fragile compositions. Gravity, light, and shadows are essential components. Every aspect is of consequence, and question the limits of our perception. The works become subtle and restrained visual poems. Each only a few lines long, but addressing the universal. The audience is reminded of the elegance and beauty of overlooked details in their lives outside the gallery that are overwhelmed by the urgency and onslaught of daily life. (Tim Hawkinson)
